Who are Family, Friends and Neighbor Caregivers?

You are a large and important group of Minnesota called Family, Friend and Neighbor Caregivers because you care for children who are a part of your extended family, neighborhood, or circle of friends.

You are providing unlicensed child care and though you may not get paid for the work you do, you are a part of this group.

The time you spend with children everyday is important to the children you care for, their families and our community as a whole.

Your work plays a key role in preparing children for success in school and life. To qualify for our services, the children you care for must be 6 weeks-12 years of age and the parents/guardians must be working, looking for work or attending school at the time the care is being provided.
