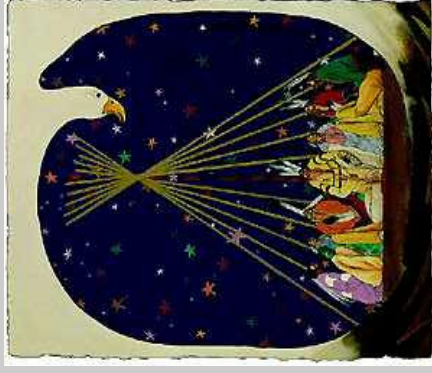

Session begins Tuesday, February 7th at the Abinoojii Akii site, across from the Community Center, from 5- 6:30 pm.

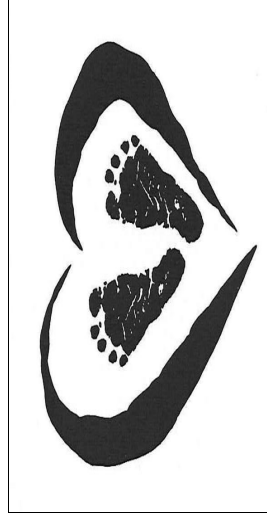
5:5-5:30 Families meet, greet & eat

5:30 Children 6 and over attend supervised activities across the street; children under 6 stay at Abinoojii Akii for activities with ECFE* staff, and adults participate in a facilitated parenting topic on site.

6:15 Families meet back at Abinoojii Akii for closing activity. Done by 6:30!

*Early Childhood Family Education (ECFE):

- *recognizes the importance of parents & families as a child's first and most important source of nurturing & learning
- *offers parents resources to enhance parenting skills
- *allows time for families to socialize, make friends, and learn from each other
