Subsidy Program Summary

The purpose of the Leech Lake Subsidy Program is to help low income American Indian parents who are working, enrolled in an educational program, or attending job training pay for childcare costs when they cannot receive services from any other agencies.

The program will pay for a portion of childcare costs according to a family's income and size.

Parents are given the option to select any legal child care setting. A legal child care setting is defined as any licensed child care center, licensed family/group child care provider, in home child care or informal caregiver providing care within our service area.
