- **Leech Lake Subsidy Program:** The purpose of the Leech Lake Subsidy Program is to help low income, Native American parents or legal guardians, who are working, enrolled in an educational program, or attending job training pay for childcare costs. - **Early Learning Scholarships:** The Early Learning scholarship can be used to help pay for a qualifying early learning program such as family child care, center child care, and public school programs.
