



Attention Tribal Child Care Providers

Due to the low demand, Minnesota Tribal Resources for Early Childhood Care (MNTRECC) will not be awarding Regional Grants to programs that meet the eligibility for MNTRECC services. However, beginning on September 1, 2022, these programs can still apply for Regional Grants through their local Child Care Aware agency.

Individuals or programs are eligible for MNTRECC services if they:

- Are an enrolled member of a federally recognized tribe, or
- Are a first or second generation descendent of an enrolled member, or
- Are licensed or funded by a Tribal Government, or
- 50% of children in care are of American Indian Descent.

When a MNTRECC-eligible program applies for a grant, they will still apply as they have in the past using the MNTRECC Grant portal on Develop, following the [instructions on Develop](#). This will allow a Child Care Aware Grant Administrator to identify, review and score their application. They should not apply using the Regional Grant portal.

Programs will be notified if they received a grant after the application period closes on September 25, 2022.
